We did it! CITES Protections Take Effect

We fought for it, and now it's happening! In 2013 Sea Save Foundation participated in CITES (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species) in Bangkok, Thailand. We added our voice as part of a united scientific, NGO, and government effort to enact international policy to protect endangered species. We celebrated a huge victory when seven new marine species were placed on Appendix II, which would afford them international oversight and protection.

Our efforts in Thailand seem to have happened so long ago, but just this month all those hard-earned protections took effect. Now oceanic whitetip sharks, scalloped hammerheads, manta rays, and others must be sustainably and legally harvested for trade around the world.

CITES is a treaty intended to ensure that international trade does not threaten the survival of any plant or animal, and these regulations are a big step toward achieving that goal.
